Secretary, Ministry of Ayush, Government of India is the Chairperson of YCB. Joint Secretary, Ministry of Ayush, Government of India is the Vice Chairperson of YCB. Secretariat of YCB is headed by Head of Institution who is the Director of Morarji Desai National Institute of Yoga.

Aim

The aim of YCB is to bring quality and standards in practice of Yoga and to promote Classical Yoga as a career skill.

Who can get certification?

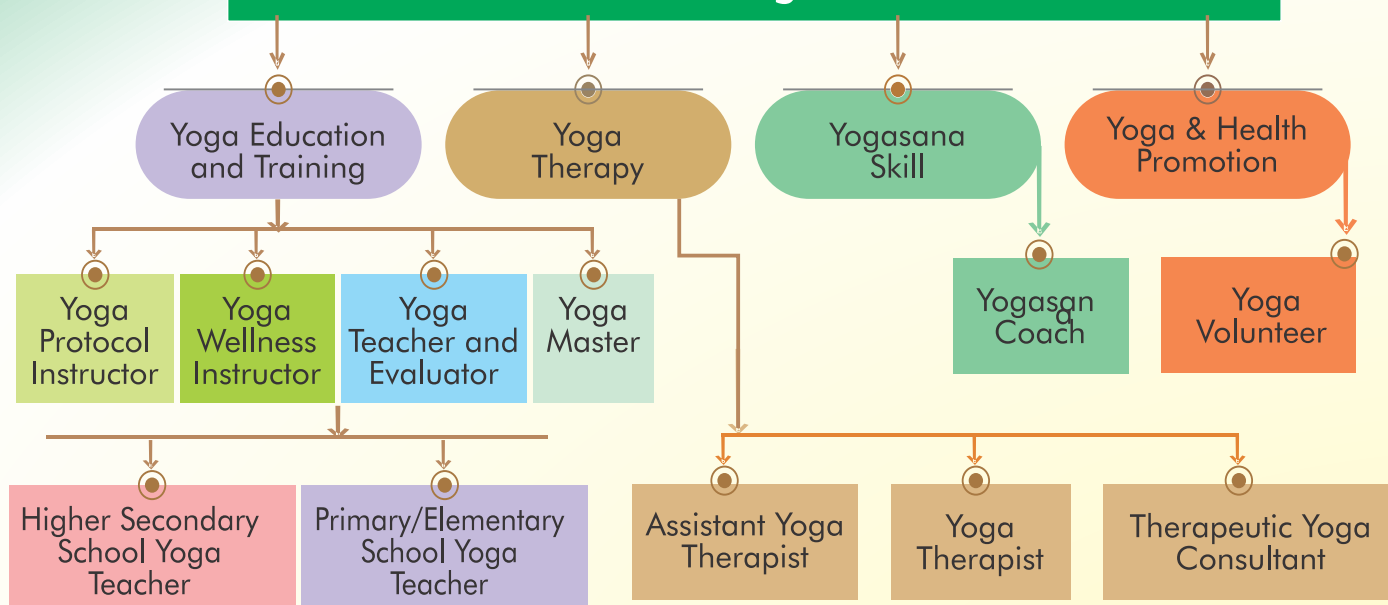
- Students studying in the YCB accredited Institutions.

Certification of Yoga Professionals



Certification Under Yoga Education and Training

Name	Certificate holder can function as
Yoga Protocol Instructor (YPI)	Yoga Instructors for teaching basics of Yoga to teach Common Yoga Protocol developed by the Ministry of Ayush for International Day of Yoga. For classes in parks, societies etc. for prevention of diseases and promotion of health.
Yoga Wellness Instructor (YWI)	Yoga Instructor to teach Yoga for prevention of illness and promotion of wellness in schools, Yoga studios, work places, Yoga wellness centers/Primary Health wellness care Centre etc.
Yoga Teacher & Evaluator (YT&E)	Master Trainers in Yoga educational institutions, Yoga training courses and training programs. He or she can also act as evaluator and assessor of Yoga professionals. Can teach in studios, institutions, colleges/universities/institutions of higher learning.
Yoga Master (YM)	Shall act as Master Educator / Trainer in Yoga educational programs & skilled professionals can teach, evaluate & assess for all levels & will be a guiding force.
Primary / Elementary School Yoga Teacher	Certified Yoga School teacher to teach Yoga for prevention of illness and promotion of wellness in schools kids.
Higher Secondary School Yoga Teacher	Certified Yoga School teacher to teach Yoga for prevention of illness and promotion of wellness in schools kids.
Yogasana Coach	Master Trainers in Sports Academy, Yoga training Courses and training programs. He or she can also act as Evaluator and assessor o Yoga professionals. Can teach in stadium, studios, Institutions, colleges/universities/Institutions of higher Learning.
Yoga Volunteer (YV)	For promotion of wellbeing of oneself and society at large; assist in conducting group classes for Yoga Volunteer, Yoga classes in the park, Yoga related IDY programs. Can be part of Fit India Movement. Can conduct Yoga break protocol at work places.

Assistant Yoga Therapist (AYTh)	Can work under supervision of certified physician or certified Yoga Therapist & Yoga Consultant on specific disorders.
Yoga Therapist (YTh)	Can work along with certified physician or certified Yoga Consultant to give Yoga Therapy on all disorders.
Therapeutic Yoga Consultant (ThYC)	Can provide Yoga Therapy for the treatment of diseases in medical setups. He should be a registered medical practitioner in any stream.

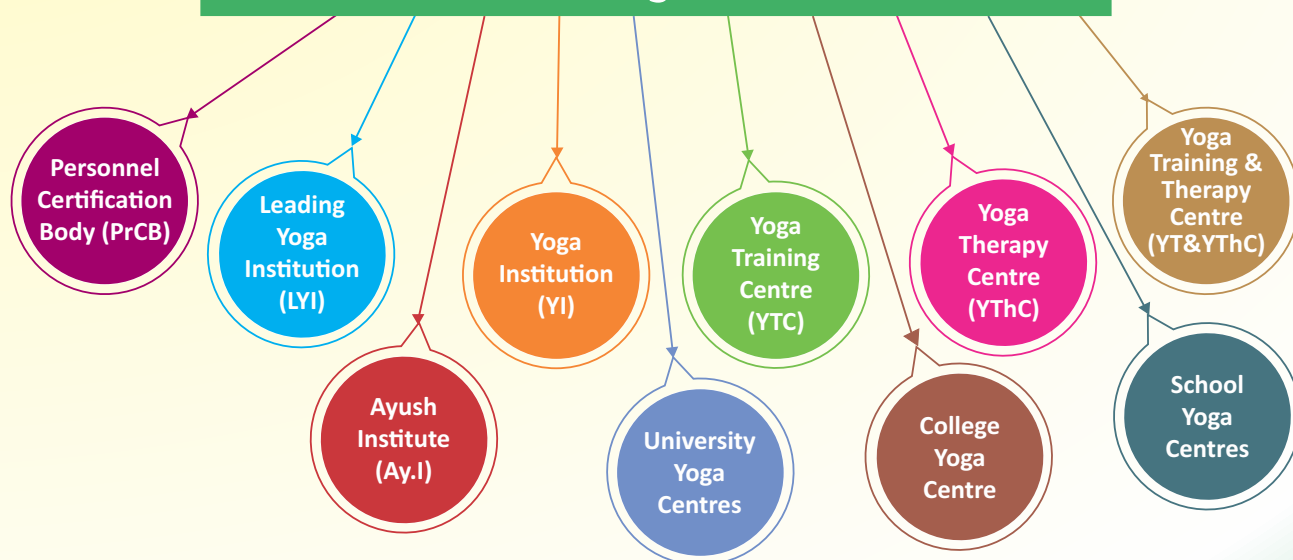

Accreditation / Recognition of Institutions



Personnel Certification Bodies (PrCBs):

YCB approves organizations who are authorized to conduct assessment of Yoga professionals on behalf of the Yoga Certification Board. Any organization fulfilling the criteria set by YCB can work as PrCB.

Leading Yoga Institutions:

The Yoga institution that has been in existence for a minimum of 15 years following a legacy of Yoga Tradition (parampara) and has contributed to the body of knowledge in the field of Yoga education/training/therapy for at least 10 years will be termed as Leading Yoga Institutions.

Yoga Institutions:

The Yoga institution which has contributed to the body of knowledge in the field of Yoga education / training / therapy for at least 5 years and has produced quality yoga professionals will be termed as Yoga Institutions.

Yoga Training and Therapy Centers:

The Yoga center which is in existence for minimum 4 years and imparting training in Yoga and Therapy and has produced quality of Yoga Teacher and Therapist will be termed as Yoga Training and Therapy Centers.

Yoga Training Centers:

The Yoga center which is committed towards promotion of health and wellness through Yoga for at least 2 years and has produced quality Yoga professionals will be termed as Yoga Training Center.

Yoga Therapy Centers:

The Yoga centers which is in existence for minimum 4 years and imparting Yoga training therapy and has produced quality of Yoga Therapist will be termed as Yoga Therapy Centers.

Ayush Institutes:

Ayush Institutes should have at least 02 YCB certified Yoga Instructors and conduct minimum 02 yoga sessions per week at their premises.

School Yoga Centre (upto 12):

The School should have at least 01 certified Yoga Instructors and conduct minimum 02 yoga sessions per week at their school.

College Yoga Centre:

College Yoga Centre which is running Under Graduate and Post Graduate Courses should have at least 02 YCB certified Yoga Instructors and conduct minimum 02 yoga sessions per week at their college.

University Yoga Centre (UGC recognized):

The University should have at least 02 YCB certified Yoga Instructors and conduct minimum 02 yoga sessions per week at their University.

Observer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Professional with Minimum Postgraduate and at least 10 years of experience in assessment/ accreditation/conducting exam etc. Must not be associated with assessing agency
Lead Examiner	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any Postgraduate (Master) Degree with 1 year diploma in Yoga or subject related to Yoga with at least 5 years of experience in teaching & training of Yoga. “OR” Postgraduate (Master) Degree in Yoga or subject related to Yoga with at least 5 years of experience in teaching & training of Yoga.
Examiner	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any Bachelor Degree with minimum 1 year diploma in Yoga or subject related to Yoga with at least 3 years of experience in teaching & training of Yoga. “OR” Postgraduate (Master) Degree in Yoga or subject related to Yoga with at least 3 years of experience in teaching & training of Yoga All the examiners shall have to be Yoga Teacher & Evaluator (YT&E) Certified Yoga professionals.
